


## Saitama WABI SABI Grand Festival 2019




Railway Diorama

#### Hikawa Shrine

An prominent shrine considered to be one of the oldest in Japan, which is also the origin of the name Omiya. Step into history among old Japanese cedars and ancient pine trees which stand in the extensive precint boasting 99,000m.
